She won numerous District and Sectional Championships, was ranked #1 in the Midwest section many times and was ranked as high as #3 in the USTA Girls National 14's and #5 in the USTA Girls National 16's. Went on to play #1 singles for the University of Michigan.
- Coached Andrew Seni who was ranked as high as #2 in the Midwest Section in Boys 12's in 1991 and #5 in the Midwest Section in Boys 14's in 1993. Went on to play at Ball State.
- Coached Tracy Zobrist from 1990 to 1994. Ranked top 5 in the Midwest Section and top 40 nationally. Played at the University of Wisconsin.
- Coached Michael Rubin who was ranked #1 in the Midwest and #25 Nationally in the Boys 18's in 1998.
- Coached Lingda Yang who was ranked top 40 nationally in the Girls 14's in 1998.
- Coached numerous other players that were ranked in the Midwest Section and Nationally.
- Have coached and developed over 75 players that have went on to play college tennis and received college tennis scholarships.
- Coach of USTA Midwest Section National Zonal Team 7 years.
- Coach of USTA Dayton Area Training Center 9 years.
- Coached Schroeder Tennis Center's USTA Adult League Ladies 4.5 Senior Team that won Midwest Section in 1998 and advanced to nationals.

- Started, organized, and coached the 2016 and 2017 Tipp Middle School Tennis Team. We had 18 players on the team the 1st year, and 48 players the 2nd year. We had a 7 week season with 10 matches and a season ending event with 4 other Middle School Teams.
